SUMMARY CONCLUSION

Risk Level: 1 (Common)

Presence of clinical findings within normal limits, often observed in high-performance sport horses. Good prognosis.

GENERAL EXAMINATION

- Vaccination status: Correctly vaccinated against tetanus, influenza, and rhinopneumonia
- Parasitic status: Monitored and dewormed every 3 months
- General condition / Body score / Mucous membranes: Good condition, BCS 2.5–3/5
- Cardiovascular auscultation (at rest & post-effort): Normal frequency and sounds, regular rhythm

- Respiratory auscultation (at rest): Normal respiratory rate and pattern, no abnormalities
- Behavior / Attitude / Stereotypies: No abnormal behavior observed
- Skin examination: No visible abnormalities
- Oral cavity: Presence of two small wolf teeth
- Digestive sounds: Normal in all four quadrants
- External genitalia: No visible or palpable abnormalities; castration scars present
- Ophthalmological exam: Normal direct and fundoscopic exam
- Neurological exam: No detectable abnormalities

CLINICAL AND LOCOMOTOR EXAMINATIONS

- Feet: No abnormalities noted
- Shoeing: Barefoot on all four feet
- Conformation: Slight toe-in deviation on left forelimb

PALPATION & MANIPULATIONS

- Back palpation: Flexible and well-tolerated
- Passive flexions (fore & hindlimbs): No sensitivity
- Suspensory ligament / Flexor tendon palpation: No pain or deformity

LOCOMOTION EXAMINATION

- Figure-eight at walk – hard surface: No signs of ataxia or lameness
- Straight line at walk and trot – hard surface: Good movement

FLEXION TESTS

- Forelimb left (LF): Negative
- Forelimb right (RF): Negative

- Hindlimb left (LH): Negative
- Hindlimb right (RH): Negative

CONCLUSION AND RISK LEVELS

This conclusion is based on the conditions under which the pre-purchase exam was conducted, the information provided, the level of investigation requested, and the examinations performed. The findings reflect the horse's health status at the time of the evaluation. Future health and performance will also depend on management and use conditions.

- Risk 1 (Common): Normal findings in clinical exam; good prognosis
- Risk 2 (Limited): Secondary, manageable risk; minor impact; routine care may be needed
- Risk 3 (Moderate): Potential performance impact; may require ongoing management
- Risk 4 (Major): Serious clinical findings likely to compromise long-term use, even with treatment
